



Certified Scrum Product Owner Course



In the big, we will explore questions like:

customers and find business success.

- Why to use Agile? When is Scrum the right approach? When should we use some other approach? Can I combine different approaches?
- What am I **expected** of the Product Owner role? How do I **interact** with the Development Team and the Scrum Master, or with the stakeholders?
- How do I **plan** for future? What kind of **commitments** are safe to make? How do those commitments affect the work we do?

In the small, we will look at things like:

- How can I effectively describe the things / features my clients and users want? How much detail is useful, and when?
- How can I get the Development Team's feedback on risks, opportunities, effort and consequences of planned work?
- What techniques can I use to elicit needs and value information from my stakeholders? How do I keep them informed of product progress?

Agile Planning and Estimating Training

Target Audience:

Software engineers and business people who are, in any way, involved in software development using Agile.

Content:

- Agile Planning
 Introduces the agile approach to planning. Story Points are explained.
- Relative Sizing Exercise
- Techniques for Estimating

This module discusses several techniques for agile estimating, such as estimate by analogy, disaggregation and planning poker. Three levels of planning are mentioned (release plan, iteration plan and daily plan). Velocity-driven and commitment-driven iteration planning approaches are discussed.


Petri generally gets great reviews from the people participating in his trainings. He has an interactive style, and a lot of exercises, and is able handle most questions people toss at him.
